1) Rome: 10.000 in the streets against troop deployment to Lebanon, in support of resistance
 On the occasion of the international day of action against war and occupation on September 30, 2006, some 10.000 took to the streets in the Italian capital. For several reasons the demonstration marks a significant turn of the anti-war movement:

It is the first time that the common platform of a national demonstration in continuity of the anti-war movement in Italy is clearly anti-imperialist. It not only gives open support to the popular resistance movements in Palestine, Lebanon and Iraq without distancing themselves from the Islamic currents. But with the demand to withdraw the troops from Lebanon it also frontally attacks the new Italian left liberal government which together with France tries to play the role of the lead nation.

3) European anti-imperialists organise solidarity congress with Bolivarian Venezuela

Several anti-imperialist forces together with revolutionary intellectuals call for an European

solidarity congress with the struggle of the Venezuelan people for a new mandate for Hugo Chavez. The congress is scheduled to take place on October 28-29, 2006, in Duisburg, Germany. The agenda is structured around three axis: a) Inform public opinion about the achievements of the Bolivarian process and the challenges for a new mandate. b) Discuss the proposal of president Chavez for an "alternative anti-imperialist movement" against the US which he put forward during the World Social Forum in Caracas. c) Exchange proposals and ideas about a new project of transition to socialism inspired by the Venezuelan experiences.

Evoked by the anti-imperialist politics of Chavez the interest all over the world to better know and eventually join hands with the Venezuelan people's struggle against the Northamerican empire is growing. Especially among the Arab-Islamic people president Chavez is emerging as a symbol of the new phase of anti-imperialist resistance.

Therefore also representatives of the resistances in Palestine and Lebanon will attend making the conference a space to work on the unity of the resistance movement of such different regions as Latin America, the Middle East and Europe.

6) Another episode proving the end of U.S. constitutional rights
Lawyer Stewart faces 30 years for having legally defended Muslim cleric

Radical human rights attorney Lynne Stewart has been falsely accused of helping terrorists. Now convicted, she faces 30 years in prison. On Tuesday, April 9, 2002, she was arrested and agents searched her Manhattan office for documents. She was arraigned before Manhattan federal Judge John Koeltl. This is an obvious attempt by the U.S. government to silence dissent, curtail vigorous defense lawyers, and install fear in those who would fight against the U.S. government's racism, seek to help Arabs and Muslims being prosecuted for free speech and defend the rights of all oppressed people.
