We are shamed to have received information, relating to the sexual assault of eight members of the Iraqi police force, by a group of misfits, which the the USA call their army.

The incident occurred in September, at the Al-Qayyara base which is about 50 kilometres south of Mosul and is being administered by US forces.

The assault was public and conducted in front of other members of the National Guard and was also directed against eight people, who happened to come from the same family.

The assault has been confirmed by a relative of the persons involved and they have also confirmed the Iraqi resistance have notified the residents of Al-Qayyara and Mosul about this incident.

The Iraq Solidarity Campaign is appalled by the actions of US troops and further questions the legitimacy, integrity and policing by senior officers of their troops.

As the UK is the final remaining US ally, we assert that our government is equally culpable.
